 immaculate condition, with firm fairways, little trace of water damage, and greens that are running at almost at summer speeds.

The Board and Staff is committed to making golf at Shadow Hills the very best experience possible, for players of all levels.

- Shower before swimming
- Wash your hands after using the rest room
- Take young children on bathroom breaks
- Be courteous of younger children and avoid excessive rough housing
- Please use the pool changing rooms not the locker rooms whenever possible
- Please be respectful of other when using your cell phone


## Shadow Hills will do the following:

- Build a covered area on the south side of the pool deck to provide shade
- Improve cleanliness in all areas, specifically the changing rooms and bathrooms
- Address the bee issue, be proactive in the spring before it is an issue
- Install a music system that allows it to be in the background. Music Friday - Sunday using a specific Shadow play list
- Continue to work on service to members by the snack bar staff
- Communicate last call
- Make internal changes that eliminates ordering down times.
- Improve healthy snack options
