The pool rules are in place to make your experience at the pool as enjoyable as possible. For the safety and fairness to all members, please follow these Pool Usage Rules.

- Members and guests that come to the pool must sign in at the pool snack house, please don't make the employees hunt you down.
- All guests must be accompanied by a member, sending a guest to use the pool without being present is not allowed.
- The guest fee is \$6.00 per person and any family member that is not a member of the club will be charged a guest fee.
- The guest fee for grandchildren is \$3.00.
- Please keep guests to a minimum, this is a private pool and first & foremost for our members.
- Please close and sign your bill before leaving the pool for the day.

This is such a great time of year to be out at the club, whether you choose to golf, have lunch or dinner on the patio or lounge, or relax by the pool. The grounds around the clubhouse along with the rural setting of Shadow Hills provide a wonderful atmosphere during the day as well as after dark. Take advantage of your own private resort.

GHIN Handicapping & Rules

Posting Scores

Fair handicapping depends upon full and accurate information regarding a player's potential scoring ability as reflected by a complete scoring record. Every player must be responsible for posting all acceptable scores, as defined below.

Scores to Post: To post a 9-hole score, the player must play 7 to 12 holes, and at least 7 holes must be played under the Rules of Golf. To post an 18 hole score, the player must play at least 13 holes under the Rules of Golf.

Scores in All Forms of Competition: Scores in both match play and stroke play (9-holes or 18-holes) must be posted for handicap purposes. This includes scores made in match play, in multi-ball, or in team competition in which players have not completed one or more holes or in which players are requested to pick up when out of contention on a hole.

A player who starts, but does not complete a hole or is conceded a stroke must record the most likely score for handicap purposes. The most likely score may not exceed the players ESC limit.

If a player does not play a hole, the score recorded for that hole for handicap purposes must be par plus any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive on that hole.
