## There's More to Our Dress Code Than Our "No Denim" on the Course Policy...

While Shadow Hills Country Club is known for our relaxed, family-friendly environment, it is important to remember that we are, at our heart, a country club. Along with this designation comes a Dress Code that establishes a sense of pride and decorum for our entire facility.

With so many new members, the Board and Staff want to remind our members of the basics rules of dress, while relying on the membership to respect the rules both in spirit and practice.

### GOLF COURSE and FACILITY DRESS CODE

Golf Attire: The purpose of a dress code at Shadow Hills is to ensure appropriate golf attire is worn by members, guests and staff. The following guidelines are intended to assist members and staff in understanding what appropriate golf attire means, and how it applies to all members, age 13 and up:

#### Golf Course and Practice Facility

- Shirts are to have collars and sleeves, unless contemporary mock turtle neck (*if you actually own one!*).
- Sleeveless shirts may be worn by women provided they have full back panels and broad shoulder panels.
- Shirts are encouraged to be tucked in, unless tailored for outside wear (example: Hawaiian or have even sewn hemline at hips that leaves pockets exposed).
- Caps and visors will have bills forward.
- Shorts/Skorts/Skirts and similar attire must be approved golf attire as sold in golf shops and must be in good taste. No crop tops or bare midriff allowed.
- Clean and neat denim may be worn only between November 1 and March 31

#### Club House Lounge, Dining Room and Patio

- Golf course attire is acceptable anytime. Tee shirts, crop tops, etc. are not allowed.
- Clean and neat denim is allowed anytime.
- **The staff of Shadow Hills reserves the right to deny members or guests access to the course, lounge or dining room, if they are dressed inappropriately or disrespectfully.** Golf spectators shall adhere to the golfer's dress code. Exceptions may be made for special golf events.

**Our annual Flag Tournament is on the 4th of July.** Tee Times are available as the tee sheet opens a week in advance for Holidays, so call the pro shop to book your tee time! The format of the tournament is you take your handicap and add it to the Par of the course (72). You will play until you reach your par-handicap number and then plant your flag in that spot on the course. The goal is to make it as far as you can and some players will make it past 18 holes, where you would just tee off on Hole one again until you run out. It costs \$10 to participate and you just sign up in the pro shop to participate but you will make your own tee time for that day, so you can play throughout the day.

**The Men's Senior Member-Guest is taking place July 14th and 15th** with practice rounds and the Horse Race taking place on July 13th. If you are 50 and over and wish to play, there is still room! It is sure to be a great tournament with the format being a Best Ball on Thursday and a Chapman on Friday. Entry forms can be found on the Shadow Hills website or in the golf shop.

We will be having a **Crazy 8 on July 22nd** with the theme being Western Days. It is a 5:45 Shotgun start and there is still room if you wish to participate, please call the golf shop to sign up! Cost is \$25 per couple for the Western Days Crazy 8.
