Pool season is here! We have made a few changes to enhance your experience at the pool.

First, we purchased a new food trailer that will service all food ordered at the pool off our pool menu. This will alleviate the influx of orders in our main kitchen, reducing the wait times in all areas of our dining service. The snack bar will continue to have beverages and snacks and all food orders will be placed at the snack bar.

Second, **pool party reservations are available Monday-Thursday from 6pm-9pm.** A monthly calendar is posted at the pool to inform everyone of when pool parties are scheduled for the entire month so you can plan accordingly.

The pool will be open on Saturday, June 3rd and Sunday, June 4th from 11am-8pm. It will reopen on Saturday, June 10th and remain open every day of the week. Pool hours are Monday-Thursday 11am-7pm and Friday-Sunday 11am-8pm.

Finally, a quick reminder of some pool rules; **the pool is for members and their immediate family members only.** Any child under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. No outside food or beverages are allowed. Shadow Hills will provide a music playlist, **as no outside music is allowed.**

The Green Report

The last month has brought Shadow Hills some fantastic golf weather. The great weather has also made for some great golfing conditions! With summer just around the corner we are starting to get some of our seasonal staff back on the maintenance crew. Our extra summer staff helps us ensure we are getting some of the extra details done while able to stay ahead of play during the busy season.



Many of you have asked about the "algae bloom" in the pond on #14. The floating green mat is actually a very small aquatic plant called duckweed. The duck weed flows in from upstream and multiplies very fast once stuck in our pond. This can make control of the weed very difficult during the growing season. Chemical applications can be tough in this pond because animals can track the herbicides onto #14 green. Our plan this year is to manually remove as much of the weed as possible with nets. If chemical applications are necessary, we will try to corral the weeds into a smaller areas to ensure the chemicals stay in place and do not get tracked onto the green.

Nice weather also means a very busy golf course. Just a reminder to all members to help do their part in keeping up the course by fixing ball marks and filling in divots.
