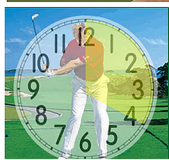

# The Green Report

Despite the stormy weather the last week of September, our fall aeration was very successful. The wet weather did not allow us to pull a core, but we were still able to solid time aerate and sand the entire golf course! The first Monday in October we will be doing our annual deep time on the greens to help with drainage throughout the winter.



The cooler, wet weather has also brought on the start of leaf season. The maintenance staff will be busy over the next couple of months keeping up with all the leaves falling. Between blowing, mulching, and sweeping we will do our best to keep the leaves under control and lost balls to a minimum!

With daily maintenance slowing down, we will also start to work on more projects around the course. This month we will begin remodeling the back nine fairway bunkers. This will be the same as the work done on the front nine bunkers last year and include: cleaning out the old sand, reestablishing the bunker edge, new drainage, and new sand. After this winter all the bunkers on the course will have been renovated!
